Postponed Hearings on BIlls

Quick update from ReBuildNH (see more info on this week's bills below)

House Office Postpones Three Public Hearings, Expects Massive Crowds!

First off, let's prove them right! The House has postponed public hearings on three RebuildNH core bills because they expect large crowds to testify in favor of them. Public hearings for HB 1431 on parental rights and HB 1131 and HB 1371 to limit masking in schools have been postponed to a date yet to be determined. We will let you know as soon as we know when and where these hearings are rescheduled for.

In the meantime, please email the committees and your own representatives with your support for these three bills. It is essential that the Legislature step in and fulfill its primary role to protect the individual rights of its citizens, and these bills will all accomplish that end.

1 p.m. – SUPPORT – <u>HB 1352-FN</u>, relative to eligibility for workers' compensation for an adverse reaction to a mandatory COVID-19 vaccination. This bill would make employees injured by an employer mandated COVID-19 "vaccine" eligible for workers compensation. Click here to register your support.

1:45 p.m. – SUPPORT – HB 1358, requiring public and private employers to establish procedures and exceptions for the use of mandatory intrusive testing as a condition of new or continued employment. This bill would limit employers ability to require intrusive COVID-19 testing for unvaccinated employees. Click here to register your support.

2:30 p.m. – SUPPORT – HB 1377, relative to unemployment benefits for employees terminated for refusing to comply with a vaccine mandate. This bill requires six additional months of unemployment benefits for employees who are discriminated against for their COVID-19 vaccination status, via termination, unpaid leave, or even through failure to schedule time for them to work. 
